



Seminar for Arabian Studies 2021 Call for Posters

The 54th *Seminar for Arabian Studies*, in collaboration with in collaboration with and supported by Casa Árabe, Cordoba, will take place over the weekends of 2-4 and 9-11 July.

Posters will be placed on the IASA website before the start of the conference and poster sessions will be scheduled during the conference. At least one of the authors must be available (via Zoom) to discuss the work presented.

Any author wishing to present a poster at the *Seminar for Arabian Studies* first needs to submit an abstract. The abstract should be 200 words maximum. It should include the title of the proposed poster; an overview of what the poster intends to present; indication of the significance of the topic; name(s), contact details (including email) and affiliation(s) of the contributor(s). The deadline for the submission of abstracts is 7th May 2021. Submissions should be sent to seminar.arab@theiasa.com.

Guidelines for Posters

Posters will be uploaded to the IASA website and should be in JPEG format and a maximum size of 2 MB. There is no mandatory font for the conference posters but we recommend that for ease of viewing you use a San Serif font (e.g. Arial).

Authors will need to send their completed posters to seminar.arab@theiasa.com by 25th June.
